PACKER PARK POOL

Status of Packer Park Community Swimming Pool

Packer Park Pool was closed on July 23, 2022, due to an amount of water loss that was deemed unacceptable for the town's water supply, especially during a summer of drought conditions. Since then, a number of repair efforts have been made to the 50+ year old pool structure, resulting in varying amounts of success. Those efforts were paused when cold temperatures required winterization and will resume when the risk of freezing pipes diminishes. It is our hope that we may open Packer Park Pool this summer and years to follow as we pursue a Master Plan for redesigning Packer Park and replacing aging facilities. 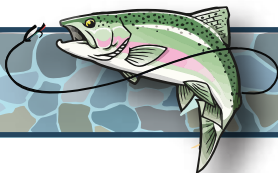

STOCKED TROUT WATERS OPEN TO YEAR-ROUND FISHING

Hamilton Lake - The PA Fish and Boat Commission has designated certain stocked trout waters for year-round fishing, Hamilton Lake among them. Anglers may not harvest trout during the period from the third Monday in February until the opening day of the regular trout season. All trout caught during this period must be immediately returned unharmed to the waters from which it was taken. See other SPECIAL REGULATIONS posted at Hamilton Lake.

The PA Fish & Boat Commission has set two Fish-for-Free Days, allowing anyone (resident or non-resident) to legally fish on Pennsylvania waterways on the designated days with NO FISHING LICENSE REQUIRED. All other regulations still apply.

NOTICE OF RESERVATION FEES

FEES FOR RESERVING BOROUGH FACILITIES

Beginning this year, there is a \$35 fee for reserving the Woodland Park Upper and Lower Pavilions and the Packer Park Pavilion. This is to help with the maintenance and preservation of our parks/pavilions, keeping them neat and orderly for your use. There will also be a \$10 fee to reserve the Packer Park Community Center for meetings.
