

EASTER EGG HUNTS



Men's Basketball - Administration Building Gym



MENTORED YOUTH TROUT DAY SAT., MAR. 28, 2026, 8:00 AM - 7:30 PM, Statewide

Youth anglers (under 16 years of age) and their adult mentors can get an early start to the fishing season at all Fish and Boat Commission stocked waters. Youth anglers must possess a free Mentored Youth Fishing Permit or Voluntary Youth Fishing License (\$2.97) and be accompanied by an adult angler (16 years and older) possessing a valid PA fishing license and a current trout/salmon permit.

FISH FOR FREE DAY SUN., MAY 24, 2026 & SAT. JULY 4, 2026, Statewide

The PA Fish & Boat Commission has set two Fish-for-Free Days, allowing anyone (resident or non-resident) to legally fish on Pennsylvania waterways on the designated days with NO FISHING LICENSE REQUIRED. All other regulations still apply.
