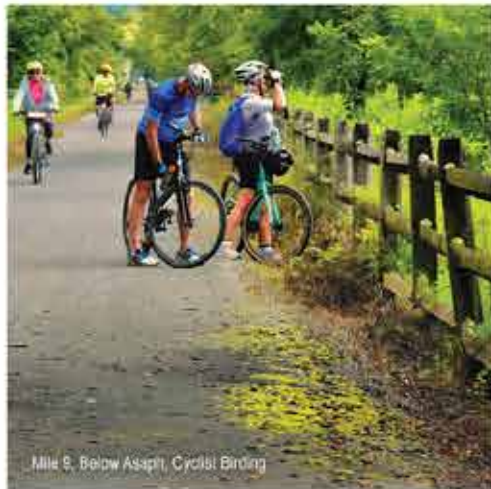

Trail of the Year Celebration

The Pine Creek Rail Trail is a trail of renewal, where history, nature, and community converge along one unforgettable path. Long before cyclists and hikers explored it, the corridor served as a trail route for the Iroquois Nation. Later, it became a working railroad transporting timber and coal through the breathtaking Pine Creek Gorge, often called the Pennsylvania Grand Canyon. Transformed into a 62-mile trail, it stretches from Jersey Shore through the gorge to Wellsboro Junction. Along its hard-packed gravel surface, the trail welcomes biking, hiking, horseback riding, and cross-country skiing, while Pine Creek provides excellent fishing and abundant wildlife. With the completion of the Pine Creek Rail Trail Extension (Marsh Creek Greenway), the trail now leads into downtown Wellsboro. The restored Charleston Street Connector Bridge serves as both a historic centerpiece and a safe crossing into town. Join our community in celebrating by attending the following events:
